SURRENDERED ITEM/LOST PROPERTY AUCTIONS

Perth Airport raises funds for charity by auctioning items lost or surrendered in our terminals. These auctions have raised more than \$850,000 to purchase lifesaving or life-changing equipment for Perth Children's Hospital.

In FY25, we donated \$224,000 to allow the hospital to purchase the latest Armeo Spring Pro device to help with the upper limb rehabilitation of children, adolescents, and young adults.

TERMINAL COLLECTION BOXES

For almost 10 years Perth Airport has collected Australian and foreign notes and coins from travellers arriving in or leaving Perth. All these funds go to a nominated local charity.

For the past two years, Guide Dogs WA has been the recipient of more than \$60,000 from these collection boxes.

Previous recipients have been Lifeline WA and the Cancer Council WA. Breast Cancer Care WA will be the beneficiary for the next two years.

CONTAINERS FOR CHANGE

With more than 17 million passengers moving through our terminals each year, recycling is important to Perth Airport. And we can help charities while we reduce our waste stream.

Since 2021 we've had special "Containers for Change" bins for recyclable drink containers that are eligible for a 10c refund.

We partner with Scouts WA to collect and sort the containers from our terminals, with Scouts WA receiving a portion of the 10c. The remaining portion is donated to a local charity partner.

In FY25, the great work of Guide Dogs WA was supported by the funds raised through the program. Breast Cancer Care WA will benefit from these funds for the next two years.
